

Terms and Conditions

Uploading content to the website

2. You grant to TEQ a non-exclusive, irrevocable perpetual licence (including the right to sub-licence) without cost to copy, reproduce, distribute, adapt and use the Material for any purpose and otherwise make it available to the public.
3. Where reasonably practical, TEQ will include an acknowledgement of the source of the Material. Where acknowledgement is not provided, you consent unconditionally and irrevocably, to the fullest extent permitted by law, to any and all acts or omissions, past, present and future, of TEQ in respect of the Material which would, but for this consent, infringe any of your moral rights (as defined in the Copyright Amendment (Moral Rights) Act 2000) in respect of the Material.
4. TEQ may monitor User Generated Content on the website, and that reserves the right to modify, edit, or remove any Material at TEQ’s discretion, without notice and for any reason. TEQ may pre-screen User Generated Content and may decide, in its discretion, without notice and for any reason, not to publish it.
